

- Primary goal: provide the best possible geotechnical, engineering, and economic advice to Indian landowners seeking to manage and develop their energy and mineral trust resources




Energy and Mineral Development Program (EMDP)

- Annual funding program
- Funding amount available varies
- Any type of energy or minerals
- Pre-development work only






Percentage of Total \$ Awarded by Resource - FY 2010 (\$11,018,370)

What kind of projects qualify?

- Energy and Mineral Projects
 - Renewable
 - Conventional
 - Mineral
- Pre-Development work
 - Resource Assessment/Exploration studies
 - Feasibility studies
 - Market studies
 - Engineering studies

EMDP - Limiting Factors

- Project must be on tribal land held in trust or restricted fee by the Federal Government
- Multi-year projects
 - Cannot award multi-year funding
 - Submit each year
 - Funds not guaranteed
- Project tasks should be accomplishable in one year

EMDP - Unfundable Tasks

- Cannot <u>purchase</u> the equipment for the <u>assessment</u> of energy and mineral resources (e.g. anemometer towers)
- Cannot <u>purchase or lease</u> the equipment for the <u>development</u> of energy and mineral resources (e.g. solar panels, wind turbine)



EMDP – Best Practices

- Contact DEMD staff to discuss project
- Send in draft for general review
- Allow plenty of response time
- Include pertinent details on project



EMDP - Best Practices

- Break down the budget
- Be specific in project tasks and what the end product is for each task
- Talk about the potential jobs this project could result in
